- 3. Improving the school environment (morale, appearance, etc)
- 4. Improving relations between the school and the community or feeder schools Here are the requirements for receiving an A on the project:
 - a. Must be able to document at least 3 hours of work on the project.
 - b. Must have a broad positive impact.
 - c. Must be well organized.
 - d. Must be creative.
 - e. Proposal must be turned in on time (by November 18)
 - f. Must be completed before January 20.
 - g. Project Planner & Activities Request completed in a timely fashion.
 - h. Must not cost money from the school.
 - i. You may work alone or with one other person.

All proposals for projects must receive prior approval from Mrs. Garcia by November 18. Scheduling for events will be assigned on a first received, first issued basis, so if you have a particular date or week in mind for your event, turn in your proposal early.
